Improved Landscaping Coming To Union Pacific Avenue Parking Lots This Fall

Thanks to a grant received from the Ifft Foundation, administered by the Idaho Community Foundation, the parking lots along the 100 to 400 blocks of North Union Pacific Avenue will get a face lift this fall. We will be removing all of the overgrown bushes, replacing the rock and planting lower growing plants and flowers. This will increase the security, increase the accessibility and add color to the public parking lots. The work should also help the perception that "there's no parking in Old Town" as most of the parking is hidden behind overgrown landscaping. We are also cleaning up the breezeway landscaping right next to Great Harvest, again overgrown and not safe for pedestrians.

In addition to the grant funds, funds raised during the Luau will help complete this project. You can help by purchasing tickets to the Luau and enjoying a wonderful night in Old Town. We will also be posting volunteer work days to help with the planting.
