The following rules for use of this dog park are in accordance with Pocatello Municipal Code (PMC).

1. Dogs shall be licensed. PMC 06.04.150
2. Dogs shall be vaccinated for rabies. PMC 06.04.080
3. Dogs shall be leashed when entering or exiting the dog park. PMC 06.04.040
4. Owners/custodians shall have control over their dogs by a whistle, noise, or other effective command at all times. PMC 06.04.040
5. Dogs which are contagious or which have an infectious disease are prohibited. PMC 06.04.080
6. Dogs convicted of a violation of dangerous conduct are prohibited. PMC 06.04.060
7. Dog owners/custodians shall remove and dispose of all feces deposited by their dog. PMC 06.04.130
8. Leaving a dog unattended or abandoning a dog at the dog park is prohibited. PMC 06.04.120
9. Training or using a dog to attack or fight humans or other animals is prohibited. PMC 06.04.110
10. Possession of alcohol in the dog park is prohibited. PMC 12.36.050
11. Dog park hours are from 6:00 a.m. until one hour after sunset, or as otherwise posted. PMC 12.36.020
12. All other Pocatello Municipal Codes shall be enforced.

Make the Most of Your Dog Park Visit!

Please keep the following in mind:

1. For their own safety and health, do not bring puppies under four months of age or female dogs in heat to the dog park.
2. Keep your dog's vaccinations current, including rabies, parvo, distemper and bordetella.
3. Limit your use of the dog park to three dogs per person per visit.
4. Be prepared to remove your dog from the dog park if it becomes aggressive or overly disruptive to other visitors (dog or human).
5. Use dog toys and training equipment sparingly so that dogs do not fight over them.
6. Spiked or pronged dog collars are not advised as they may cause injury during play.
7. Do not bring tobacco, food (dog or human) or glass containers into the dog park. Keep the dog park area free of trash.
8. Do not bring animals other than dogs into the dog park.
9. Closely supervise children who accompany you into the dog park. Encourage calm behavior by children in the presence of dogs.
10. Owners/custodians may be legally and financially responsible for any injuries or damages caused by their dog.

Directions:

The Old Town Bark Park is conveniently located just East of the parking lot on the 100 Block of North Union Pacific Avenue. When traveling West under the Center Street Underpass, turn right on Union Pacific Avenue and right into the parking lot. It's easy to find, we've included a map.

Along with Pocatello's first off-leash dog park, we've created a Pet & People Walk to encourage a social, active lifestyle for our citizens and visitors and their dogs. Just follow the yellow dots. You can travel North or South and make the loop.

The walk is roughly 5K. For your safety, please obey all stop signs and traffic lights. Along the walk you will experience Historic Old Town Pocatello, our historic neighborhood and portions of the Portneuf Greenway trails.

- Dogs must be on a leash.
